Invitation to Hear God's Truth By Michael Hickox

2 Timothy 3:16-17 teaches that "all Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works."

The Bible is our source of divine instruction. It is the means through which God reveals Himself and His will to mankind today. As the written Word of God, the Bible is infallible truth (cf. John 17:17). This truth is not just for education's sake, but relates to "*all things that pertain to life and godliness*" (2 Pet. 1:3).

The inspired truth of God teaches us how the world was created (**Gen. 1**), how makind came into existence (**Gen. 1:27**), what our purpose should be (**Ecc. 12:13**), what our great problem is (**Rom. 3:23**; **6:23a**), what God's solution is (cf. **Rom. 5:8-10**), and what we must do to be saved.

The inspired truth of God has the ability to take us from where we are to where we need to be. By hearing God's Word with the right heart, we can gain faith in the Lord (**Rom. 10:17**), and live fruitful lives (**Matt. 13:23**). By hearing God's Word and responding to it rightly, we can escape the wages of sin, which is eternal condemnation in hell, and gain hope of eternal life in heaven (**Rom. 6:23**).

We invite all to come hear lessons from the inspired Word of God this week.

The Joy of Gospel Meetings

Gospel meetings are wonderful opportunities both for those outside the body of Christ to learn and obey the truth, and for Christians to be edified.

It is a joy any time Christians assemble together to strengthen one another and worship God. The Holy Spirit's command to not forsake the assembly of the saints is prefaced by the words "*Let us consider how to provoke one another to love and good works*," (Heb. 10:24). Assembling with saints is a means by which Christians can help each other please God. Gospel meetings offer great opportunities for this.

It is likewise a joy for saints to join together to feast on the spiritual nourishment provided through God's Word (**1 Pet. 2:2**). Gospel meetings offer multiple opportunities for looking into divine truth, and doing so with others who share a desire to grow through the Word.

Gospel meetings also provide opportunities for worshipping God through singing (**Eph. 5:19**), and joining with fellow saints while approaching God in prayer.

Gospel meetings create opportunities for Christians to invite family, friends, and neighbors to come hear the saving Gospel, while benefitting ourselves through the opportunities provided.

May we appreciate opportunities such as these to be spiritually strengthened, strengthen others, and please our Creator.

"Examine Yourselves"

2 Corinthians 13:5 says "Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith..."

The need for self-examination is seen throughout Scripture. Centuries before Paul wrote to the Corinthians, certain Jews had failed to rebuild the temple as God desired of them. They were exhorted, "*Consider your ways*" (Haggai 1:5,7).

Examining ourselves and considering our ways does not mean reflecting on how we "measure up" to others (**2 Cor. 10:12**), or how we are at living like the world says we should (cf. **1 Cor. 3:19**). Rather, we must reflect on our obedience to *God's* will.

God's Word is *able* to build us up, but one of the things needed from us to be built up is honest self-examination.

Consider the example of Saul of Tarsus. Before Saul's conversion, he was wreaking havoc as he rebelled against Jesus. He recognized this when confronted by Jesus on the road to Damascus. Upon learning how wrong he was, he did not run from the truth. Instead, Saul showed a desire to make things right by saying "Lord, what wilt thou have me to do?" (Acts 9:6).

May we have a similar mindset as we search the Scriptures, reflect on how we can better serve God, and become "*doers of the Word*" when we find things that need fixed (James 1:22).

This self-examination is critical to be pleasing to God.
