Christ's Compassion

Jesus' life was filled with demonstrations of compassion. We would do well to emulate His example.

Compassion is "a sympathetic emotion created by the misfortunes of another, accompanied by a desire to help". Genuine compassion involves love, great feeling, interest, and concern.

The Gospel accounts tell of various ones on whom the Lord had compassion. Such individuals include a leper (Mark 1:40-41), a widow who lost her son (Luke 7:11-15), and two bind men (Matthew 20:30-34).

Jesus did not simply "feel sorry" for those suffering. His compassion motivated Him to do something. He healed the sick, raised the dead, and opened the eyes of the blind.

How are you at demonstrating your compassion for others?

Many are suffering both physically and spiritually. Do something!

When is a "Miracle" Really a Miracle?

A fund raising letter from a local hospital said "Miracles that come from technology. And miracles that come from human caring. I've seen them happen." This is an excellent example of the inaccurate use of the work "miracle" in modern usage.

What this man is describing IS a wonderful thing. It's great to see a sick person recover. It is thrilling to view the fruits of recent technological advances in medical care We are seeing things that folks only a few years ago never imagined. Open heart procedures, organ transplants, laser surgery and a of host medical other new methodologies have been perfected in rapid succession. It is truly amazing but it's NOT a miracle!

You see, by definition – and in accurate Bibial usage – a miracle is "an effect in the physical world which surpasses all known human or natural power...supernatural." So when a

doctor uses a sophisticated new medical device to effect the cure of a seriously ill patient, there is not a miracle involved. While the technology may be new and very advanced, it is still a procedure that is known and understood by men. It is an action that is in accord with natural law. It is not supernatural. It is NOT a miracle.

Miracles are things like: walking on water turning water into wine, raising a man who had been dear for four days; etc. These things defy a natural explanation. They are truly supernatural. The Bible records many instances of true miracles – but it also tells us that no such miracles are taking place in the world today (1 Cor. 13:8-13). No, there are no miracles at that hospital – or any place else!
